



FOOTBATHS USE, A KEY ELEMENT IN DIGITAL **DERMATITIS MANAGEMENT**

- Effective hoof disinfection via footbaths helps to limit the spread of infections in the herd
- The use of non-irritant footbath solutions promotes healthy hooves



DIGITAL DERMATITIS

The most problematic hoof infection, digital dermatitis (DD) causes major economic losses. The disease can cycle back and forth from active lesions to chronic hidden lesions. Chronic DD lesions are often ignored,

and these lesions are ticking time bombs that can revert to painful warts. THYMOX HOOF is designed to help control DD lesions and break the vicious cycle.
